What it's optimized for	Infor positions CloudSuite as industry-specialized, cloud-built ERP suites with “networked analytics” and AI-augmented UX.	Microsoft positions D365 Supply Chain Management as an end-to-end suite for manufacturers/distributors/retailers, focused on resiliency, visibility, planning, procurement, manufacturing, warehousing, and asset management.
Platform & architecture	Infor OS is the foundational platform providing horizontal services across CloudSuites and extending to third-party solutions.	D365 Finance/SCM runs on Microsoft's cloud ecosystem and is supported by enterprise admin/dev tooling and a broad platform landscape (e.g., the Finance & Operations app platform and services documented in Microsoft Learn).
Supply chain scope	Capabilities vary by the Infor product line (M3 vs LN vs CSI, etc.) and industry suite configuration.	D365 SCM explicitly calls out capability areas like supply chain planning, procurement, manufacturing/shop floor, order management, warehouse management/fulfillment, and asset management —useful for a clear migration value story.
Analytics & insight	Infor markets “networked analytics” as part of CloudSuite value; depth depends on suite and analytics stack.	Microsoft emphasizes real-time visibility and AI-driven insights in Supply Chain Management messaging, and provides extensive product documentation/training paths to operationalize it.
Roadmap velocity	Infor keeps CloudSuites current as cloud offerings; exact cadence varies by suite/contract.	Microsoft publishes “release wave” plans (what's new and planned) for D365 SCM—helpful for exec buyers who want predictable innovation visibility.
Integration approach	Infor OS is explicitly positioned to connect CloudSuites and extend into third-party apps (integration + common services).	D365 SCM provides documented integration and data management capabilities (data entities, OData, REST endpoints, etc.)—useful for modernization + app consolidation narratives.
